THE ART OF WAR – TONIGHT!

This evening, Toms River High School North will be hosting Mr. Frank Romeo of "The Art of War". Mr. Romeo was shot in 1969. He was shot 7 times and woke up months later in a hospital in Japan. After a year of surgeries around the world, he returned to the United States and has since become a successful author and speaker.

and called him a murderer and a baby killer. The last few months of his service contract were spent in a military hospital (his mental health issues, which were exacerbated by Army Doctors led to addiction).

Mr. Romeo spent 40 years battling an internal struggle with his Vietnam experience and PTSD while raising his children. He painted in private in the 1990's as a way to deal with the trauma of Vietnam. One of his paintings is now in the National Museum of Art in Washington, D.C.

Part of Mr. Romeo's current work is promoting a planned walk across NY State to increase awareness for PTSD and support a documentary film to spread his message to a national audience.

The exhibit will be open to the public at no cost on the evening of June 4. Mr. Romeo invites the students and community to learn about the war, PTSD and the plight of our veterans. He has a large exhibit of Vietnam veteran artwork and artifacts in the States. Please spread the word to anyone you think would be interested and let me know if you would like to discuss any relevant topic and presentation that can spread a positive message that has the potential to influence us all.

Please join us this evening and visit with Mr. Romeo in the Arena at Toms River High School North. The exhibit is FREE AND THE WHOLE AT 7PM.
