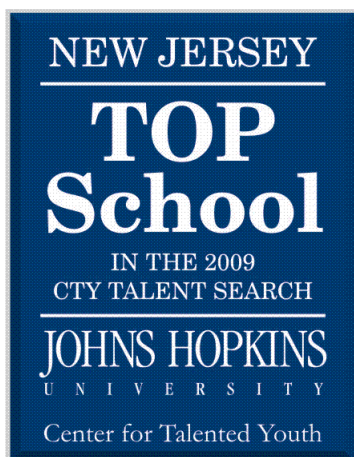

In addition to walking, our fundraising efforts at the relay included face painting, popcorn, and a mini gift auction!

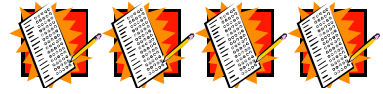
Thank you to those of you who joined us on the track as we supported those touched by cancer. Team Intermediate North had team members walking the track at all times.
