6PM

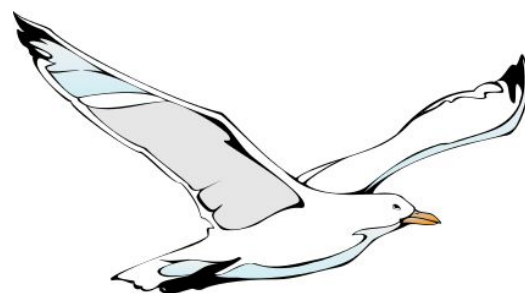
Get ready to GLOW, SOAR, RUN!

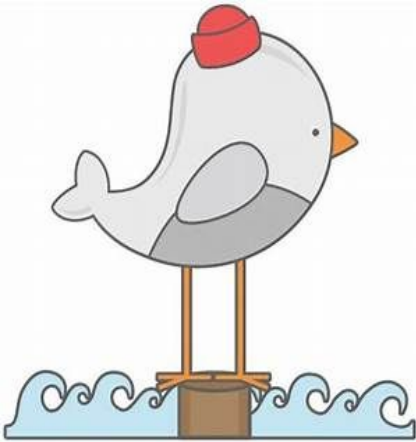
