From the SOAR Squad...



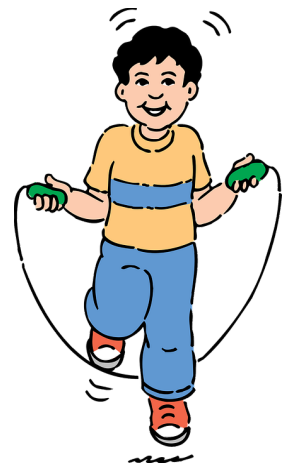
Italian Night was a huge success and we wanted to thank everyone who attended! A special thanks to the teachers and staff who set up and served almost 280 people!

Crazy Hair Day:

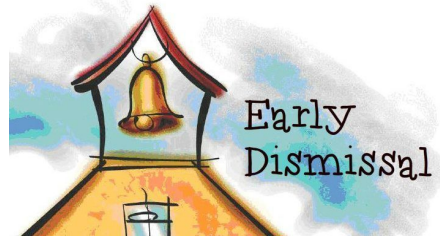

February 27th: Pretzel Day

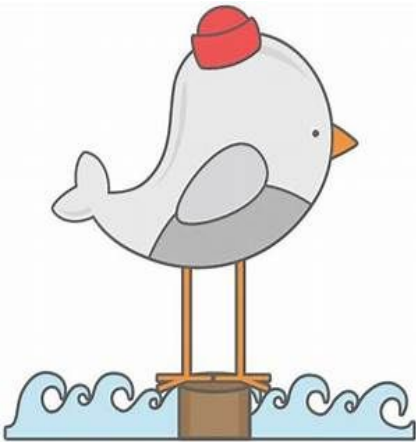
