



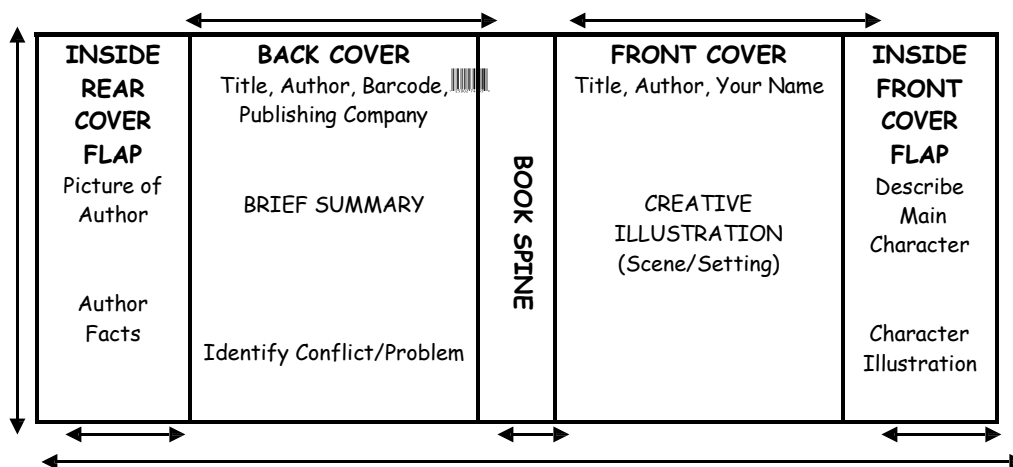
Elementary Summer Reading Book Jacket Project Option



For this project, you will create a book jacket about the book you have read.

Constructing the Book Jacket:

1. Cut a sheet of oak tag or poster board 11 inches high by 2 feet long (use any color; thicker paper tends to work better)
2. From the left side, measure in 4 inches and place a light pencil mark. Also place a mark 11 inches, then 13 inches, and then 20 inches from the left side.
3. With a ruler and a pencil, lightly draw a vertical line at each spot you measured from the top to the bottom. The oak tag or poster board can then be folded inward along the lines. Check the diagram below.



Be sure to include the items referenced on the illustration above:

- Title
- Author's name and a few facts about the author (or a creative illustration)
- A brief summary of the main topic/problem in the text
- A description of the main character
- An illustration that represents the setting

You can also choose to add additional items to your book jacket!
