**Operational:**

1. Assume responsibilities of Director of Transportation as specifically assigned when the Director of Transportation is absent.
2. To conduct the transportation activities as assigned in accordance with rules and regulations of the NJ State Department of Education and Toms River Board of Education policies and procedures. Assist in filing of proper reports as required as required by the State Department of Education and District Administration.

3. Assist in the selection and recommendation of candidates for employment for all drivers and attendants in accordance with district procedures.
