Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:38-1(d), homeless persons who reside in a school district for one year or longer shall be deemed to be domiciled within that district. The family is still displaced and has chosen to remain in Berkeley Township Schools, domiciled to the Toms River School District. Therefore, Toms River Schools is now responsible for the educational costs as of May 5, 2021.
