Connectivity Support

Families who have communicated a need for connectivity support have the option of obtaining Internet services through one of several providers at a significantly discounted rate or signing out a district MIFI for use in the home. Additionally, devices are available for every student in grades K-4 in every elementary school, while students in grades 5-12 participate in our one-to-one initiative, ensuring a device for every student in need throughout the district.

Safe Delivery of Meals for Eligible Students

Students who are placed in quarantine due to a positive COVID diagnosis can go to the home school for a weekly meal pick up.

In the event that the school or district must shift to a full hybrid or remote learning model, food services will transition to preparing packages for both weekly pick up and drop off through scheduled transportation routes.
