# Advanced Placement Report

## What is Advanced Placement?

- College-level courses and exams that you can take in high school.
  - Designed to give a student the experience of an introductory level college class before graduating high school.
  - More than 2.5 million students take AP exams every year in different subjects.
  - AP Exams are administered in schools over two weeks in May.
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# Advanced Placement Report

Taking AP courses and exams in high school could give a student an advantage in college by letting them:

- Earn College Credit and Placement
    - AP Scores can earn college credits before a student even sets foot on campus. Most AP students who enroll in four-year colleges start school with some credit.
  - Stand Out to Colleges (boost college applications)
    - AP on a high school transcript shows colleges the student is motivated to succeed, and taking the exam demonstrates the student's commitment to tackle and complete college-level work.
  - Save Money and Time
    - Earning credit or placement can open up time on a student's schedule or even to graduate early.
  - Keep Their Options Open
    - Earning college credit with AP can give a student the flexibility to change majors, pursue a second degree, study abroad, or seek internships.
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# Advanced Placement Report

Research consistently shows that AP students are better prepared for college than students who don't take AP, regardless of their exam score. They're more likely to enroll and stay in school, do well in their classes, and graduate in four years. Taking AP can help a student:

- Get a Taste of College
  - Students get familiar with college-level work - and boost their confidence by tackling it
- Develop College Skills
  - Students develop time management, critical thinking, and scholarly writing. AP courses and exams help students hone the skills they will need in college and career.
- Discover Their Passion
  - Studying a subject in depth could give a student new insights and even put them on the path to a career.
- Boost Their GPA
  - AP course, the most rigorous courses offered, are weighted higher than honors and college prep courses.

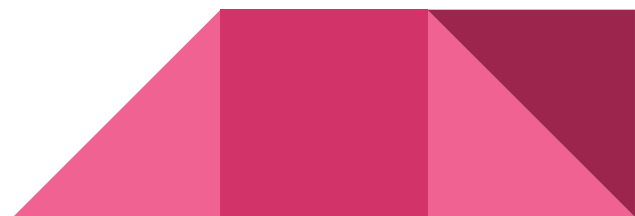

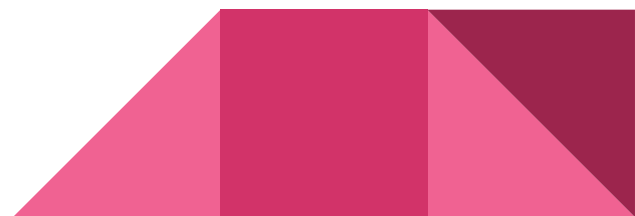
Student Participation: 2021-2022 School Year

Toms River High School North: 233 Students (481 exams)

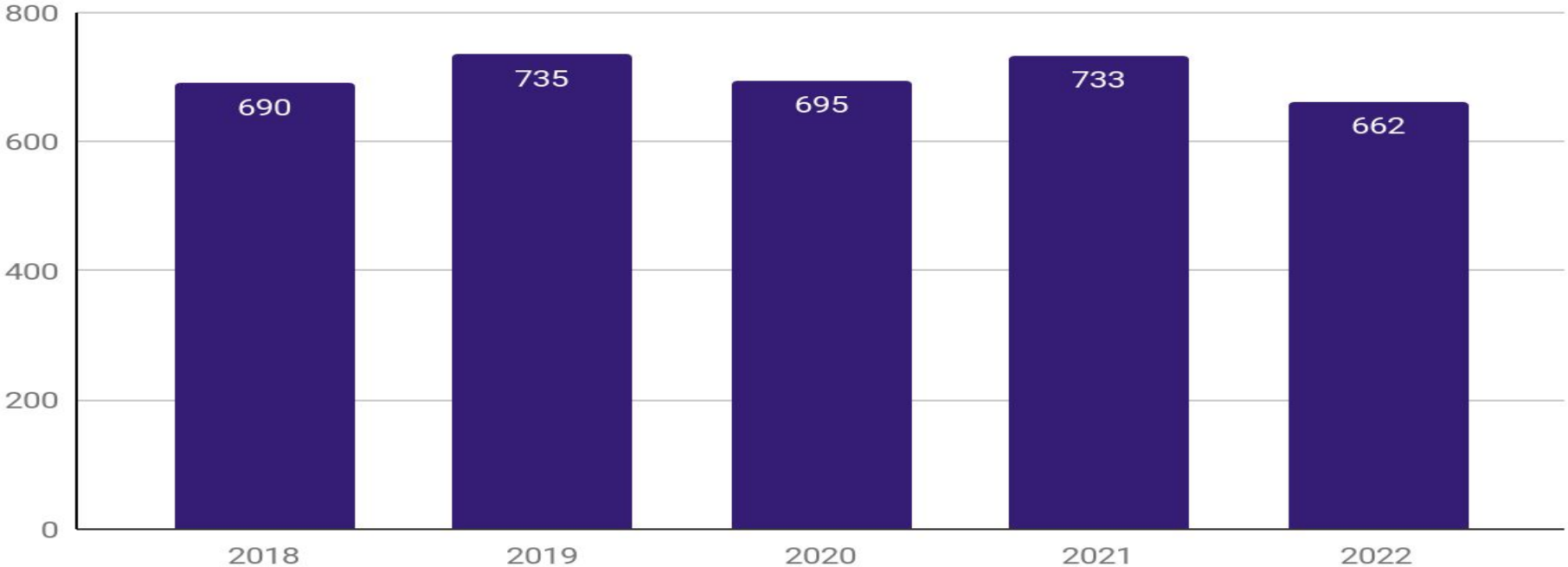
Toms River High School South: 212 Students (521 exams)

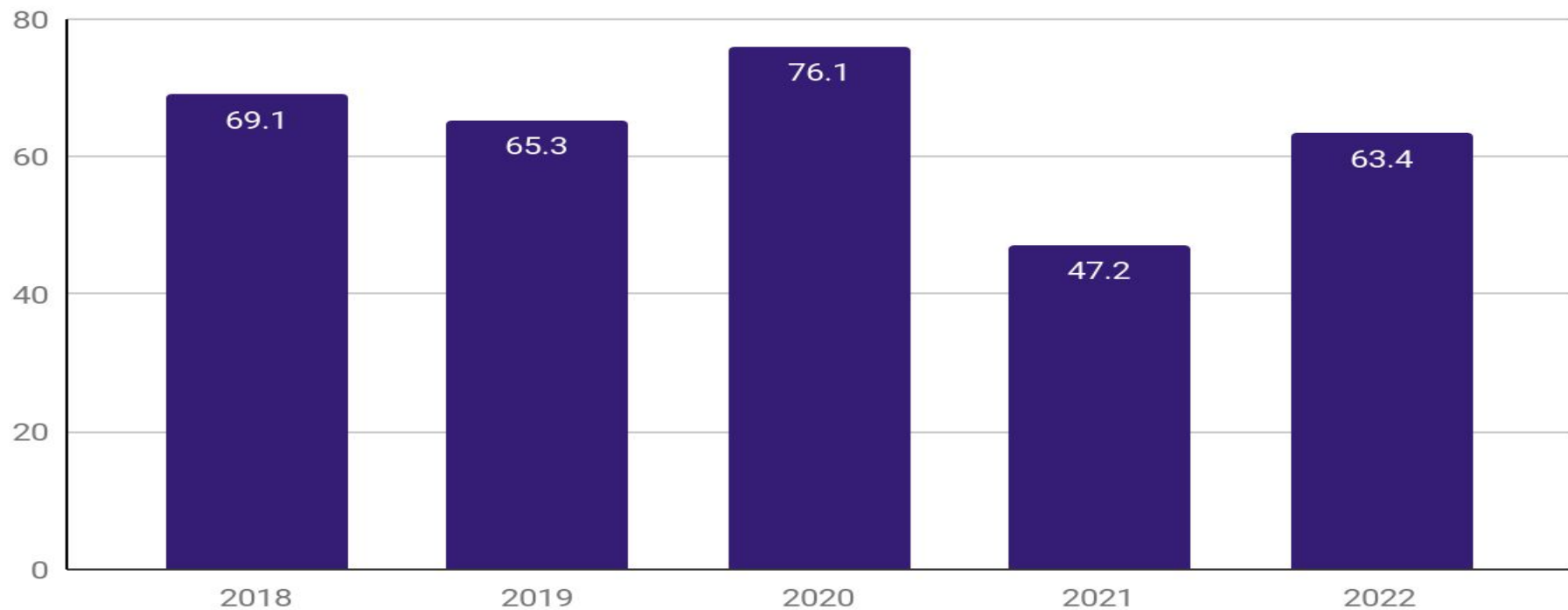

Scholar Summary: The AP Scholar Awards are academic distinctions that students may cite among their credentials. Students do not receive any monetary award from the College Board.

AP Scholar: Granted to students who receive scores of 3 or higher on three or more AP exams.

AP Scholar with Honor: Granted to students who receive an average score of at least 3.25 on all AP exams, **and** scores of 3 or higher on four or more of these exams.

AP Scholar with Distinction: Granted to students who receive an average score of at least 3.5 on all AP exams taken, **and** scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams.

What is the SAT and why take it?

- Globally recognized college admissions test that is accepted at all U.S. colleges.
- Measures the skills and knowledge that research shows are the most important for success in college.
- College and career readiness.
- Potential scholarships.
- May be required for certain programs (i.e.: NJ Teacher Preparation Program)

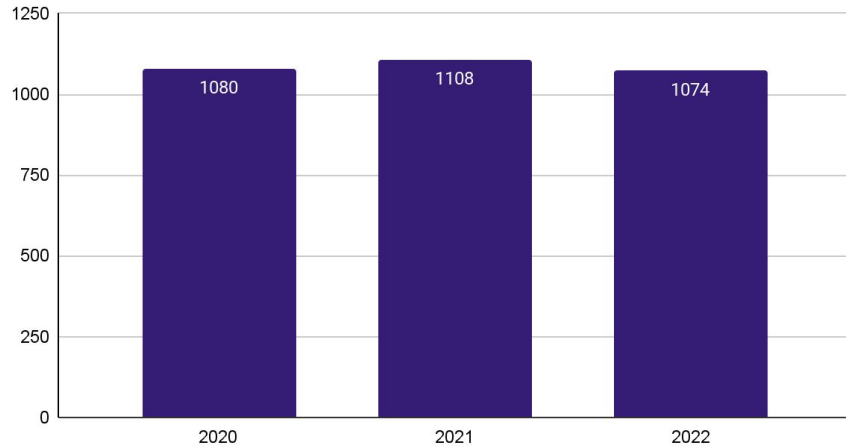

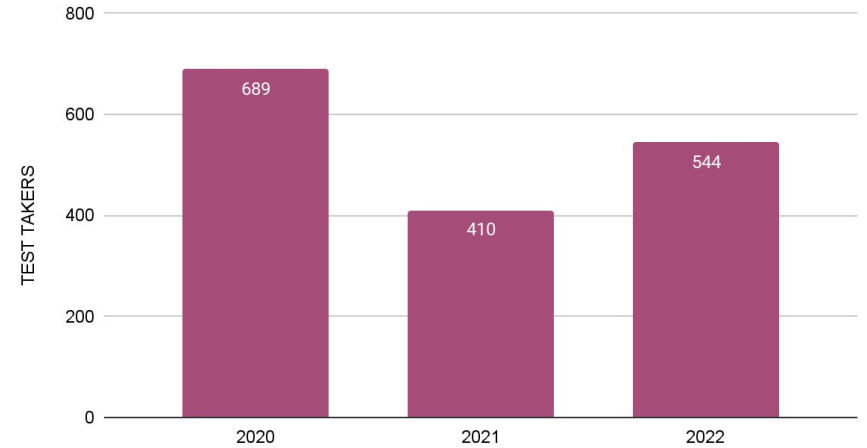

## 3 YEAR AVERAGE SCORES

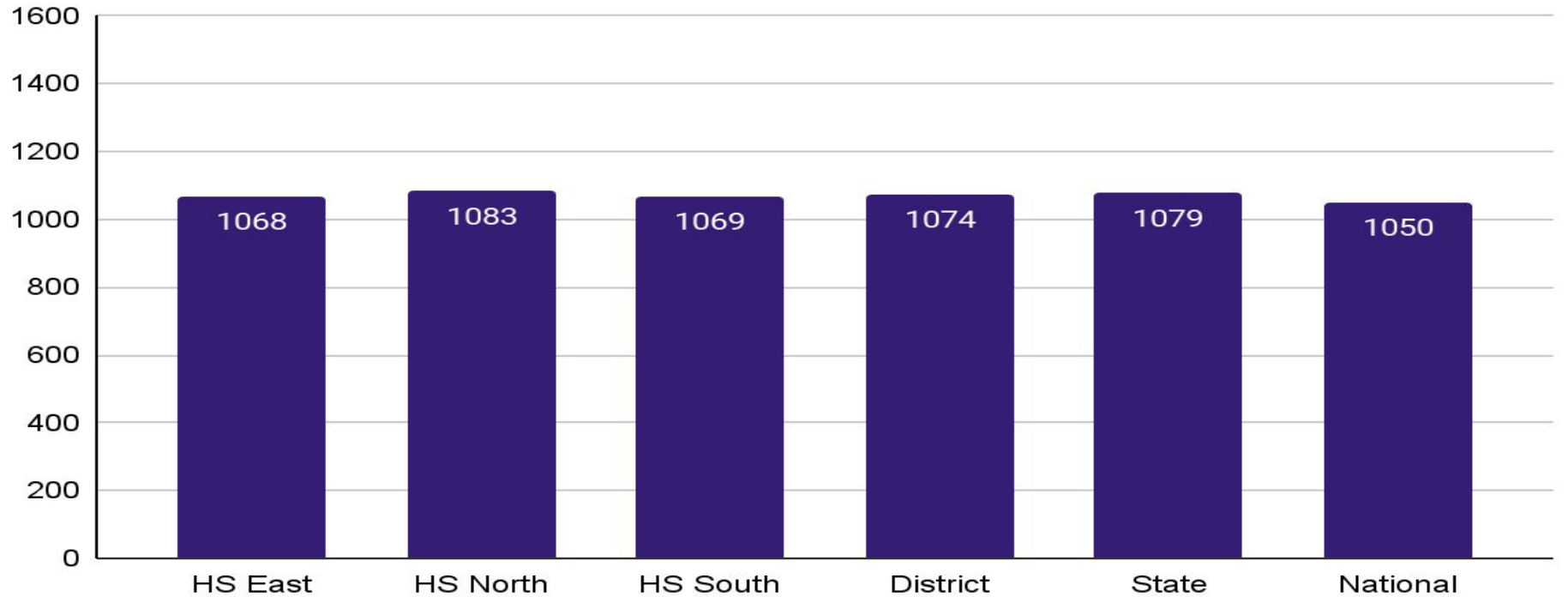


## # OF PARTICIPANTS

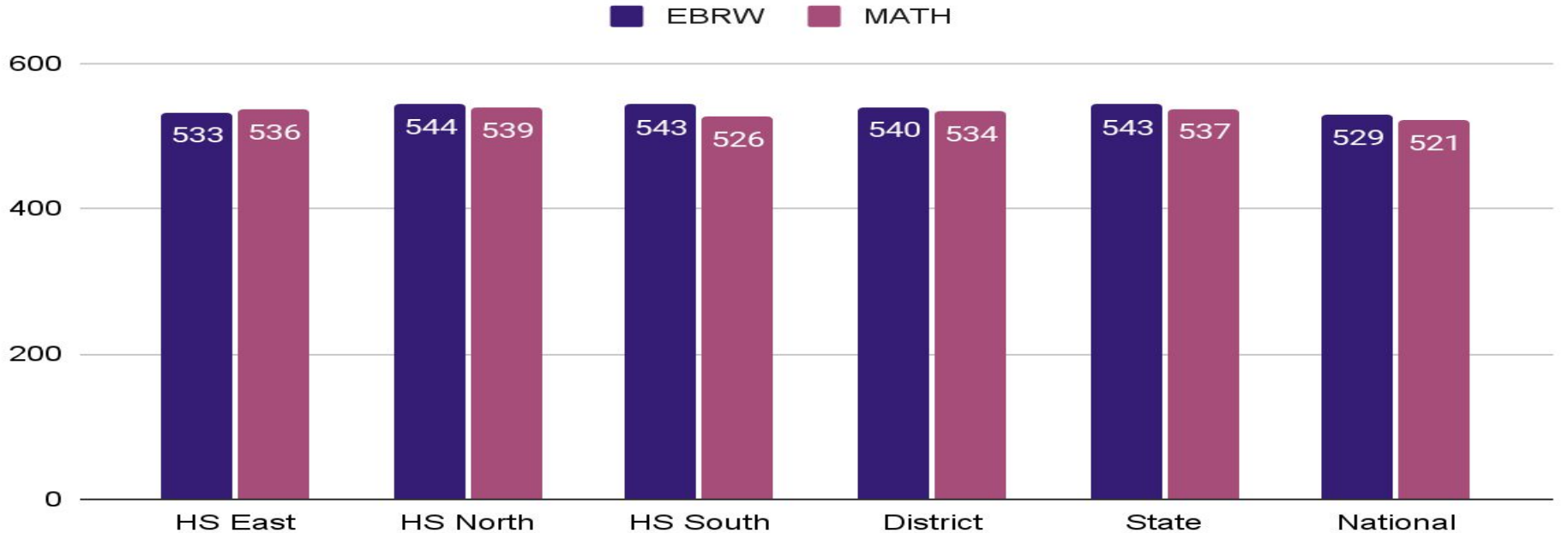
## SAT Overall Mean Score
