

On June 11 the Toms River School District celebrated the graduating seniors who are entering military service after graduation. 31 students enlisting in all branches of the military were presented with honor cords to wear at graduation. In addition to those enlisted Drew Caferell is attending Mount St. Mary's while also participating in the United State Marine Corp. PLC Training, Sophia Valeo will be attending University of South Carolina Air Force ROTC, Anisha Singh will be attending Georgia Tech Air Force ROTC and Kevin Isadore will be attending Drexel Navy ROTC. Also honored were students attending the United States Military Academies.
