

## Student Locker Clean Out and Material Return

The plan for students to remove their belongings from their personal and gym lockers has been developed. This plan is alphabetical and inclusive of all grades.

In an effort to keep everyone safe and follow state guidelines, we ask that everyone adhere to the directions provided below.

- Parents are asked to drop their child(ren) off at the main circle outside of the front door, to drive to the staff parking lot and remain in their cars.
- Students must wear a mask in the building and are encouraged to practice social distancing regulations both in the parking lot and in the hallways. Staff will be present in order to help monitor the areas.
- Students will have 15 minutes in the building. They are directed to report to their locker and empty it, place their textbooks and teacher property in the appropriate classroom (IE- math books returned to math classrooms) and then report directly to the phys ed locker room if they have belongings there.
- There will be a dropbox in the commons area for any borrowed library books to be returned.
- **Borrowed Chromebooks will not be returned at this time.** Chromebooks will remain with students through the summer and be collected when school returns to regular session.

Students may want to bring an empty backpack with them so they can place their belongings in it upon retrieval.
