I wanted to keep you all informed about our ongoing efforts to remain safe and healthy during the Covid-19 pandemic. As you know, back in February we installed desk dividers in our classrooms. While these have provided an additional precaution for students and staff, the specific white/opaque desk barriers we've been using within our grades 4 and 5 classrooms have also posed some sightline issues. With the support and guidance of the district, our school will be removing those dividers and instead installing air purifiers in grades 4 and 5 classrooms, effective on Friday, May 14.

The Vollara Air & Surface Pro utilizes Active Pure Technology, and this air purification system is the same one being used throughout our secondary schools and at other locations throughout the district.
